

## Academic Enrichment Special Friday Classes

Every Friday, the Academic Enrichment program will hold special classes on unique topics. When you register for an Academic Enrichment session, you will be asked to choose one of the three classes being offered that session. If you attend both sessions, you will pick a different class for each session.

Each session the choices will be:

- Cartoon Illustration
- Cooking
- Crime Scene Investigation

## PROGRAM COSTS

Academic Enrichment only (4 wks) - \$45 per session

Acad. Enrich. plus Early Bird (4 weeks) - \$140

Acad. Enrich. plus Early Bird (10 weeks) - \$300

### If your child qualifies for Mitch's Kids:

Academic Enrichment only (9 wks) - \$45

Acad. Enrich. plus Early Bird (10 weeks) - \$150

### Additional Notes:

Remember, if you sign up for Early Bird in addition to Academic Enrichment, your child must arrive at the Jeffers Unit prior to 8:00 am to get breakfast. Your child will then be transported to Central at 9:00 am for Academic Enrichment.

As an alternative to Early Bird, you may choose to sign your child up to attend camp any of the weeks he/she is not attending Academic Enrichment. Please note Week 5 (July 5-9) and Week 10 (Aug. 9-13) are Resident Camp weeks—participants will stay at camp all week.

### IMPORTANT!

**Members MUST bring their Boys & Girls Club Membership Card with them everyday.** This is very important so participants can scan in and out. If members show up without their cards, we will have to charge the parent a \$3 fee to have a replacement card produced.

# 2010 Summer Academic Enrichment Program

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Wayne County Summer Academic Enrichment Program is open to any Club member, from Kindergarten to 8th grade. There will be one-on-one tutoring, small group and high-yield learning activities focusing on improving reading and math fluency and career exploration.

The Academic Enrichment program will take place at the Boys & Girls Club at Central (the Central Unit), located at 1425 East Main Street, Richmond, IN. (Note: June 14th-18th the program will meet at the Jeffers Unit at 1717 South L Street.)

The Academic Enrichment program is a part of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Wayne County's 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center, Project Learn: Impact Now program. The 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC allows the Boys & Girls Clubs of Wayne County to expand educational programming and help students by establishing communication with schools to improve ISTEP+ and Acuity scores, as well as grades and attendance.

Each participant will take the Woodcock Johnson III Assessment at the beginning and the end of the program. Our goal is to improve reading and math proficiencies by 10% for students in kindergarten through second grades and by 15% for students in the third grade and above.

Parents signing their children up for Academic Enrichment also need to fill out a Mitch's Kids form. This program encourages Boys & Girls Clubs of Indiana to work with children who qualify for TANF, public housing or free/reduced lunch. This form must be completed prior to May 21<sup>st</sup>.

Students who complete 80% of the 8 week or 9 week program will receive a T-shirt, school supply pack and a certificate.

Students who complete 90% of the 8 week or 9 week program will receive a T-shirt, school supply pack, a certificate and will be able to attend the last field trip of the summer to Holiday World on Wednesday, August 11<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 AM - 10:30 PM.

## Parents please note:

You have several options to consider this year for enrollment in the Academic Enrichment program and/or any other Boys & Girls Clubs of Wayne County's Summer Fun Programs, including Early Bird and Camp Guy. Also, if your child qualifies for the Mitch's Kids program, you may qualify for a special discount to enroll in Academic Enrichment.

## Academic Enrichment Sessions

There will be 2 sessions of the Academic Enrichment program this summer. Each session runs for 4 weeks. Each session will meet from 9:00 am - 12:30 pm on Monday through Thursday and 9:00 am - 12:00 noon on Friday.

- **Session 1** will meet June 8 - July 2
- **Session 2** will meet July 12 - August 6

## Field Trips

Each session there will be 2 Wednesdays the group will take an educational field trip from 9:00 am - 4:30 pm.

**Please drop off and pick up your child at the Jeffers Unit on these days.**

- **Session 1** field trip days will be Wednesday, June 16<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, June 30<sup>th</sup>
- **Session 2** field trip days will be Wednesday, July 21<sup>st</sup> and Wednesday, August 4<sup>th</sup>

## Attending Academic Enrichment ONLY

You may choose for your child to only attend Academic Enrichment for Session 1 only, Session 2 only, or both Sessions.

Please sign in your child at the Central Unit between 8:30 - 9:00 am each day (except field trip days as listed above).

On Monday-Thursday, parents have the option of picking up their child at the Central Unit by 12:30 pm or allowing our staff to transport their child back to the Jeffers Unit at 12:30 pm to participate in our **Drop-In** program which is from 12:00 noon to 4:00 pm. Parents may then pick up their child at the Jeffers Unit anytime between 12:00 noon and 4:00 pm. **Parents must pick up their child by 4:00 pm at the Jeffers Unit or a \$2.00 late fee will be charged for every 15 minutes after 4:00 pm that the child is at the Club.**

On **Fridays**, there is NO Drop-In program at the Jeffers Unit, so participants must be picked up at the Central Unit by **12:00 noon**.

Lunch will be provided daily. **SWIMMING ON FRIDAY IS NOT PROVIDED WITH THIS OPTION!**

## Academic Enrichment / Early Bird Combination

You may choose for your child to participate in the Early Bird program from 6:30 am - 6:00 pm along with Academic Enrichment. Youth may be dropped off at the Jeffers Unit anytime between 6:30 - 8:30 am and be transported to the Central Unit for Academic Enrichment. Breakfast is served at 8:00 am as a part of Early Bird. At 12:30 pm, Academic Enrichment participants are transported back to the Jeffers Unit to complete their day with the Early Bird program.

Early Bird also allows members to participate in Friday afternoon swimming at Cordell Pool. Please be sure to send a swimming suit and towel on Fridays. If weather does not permit swimming, members will remain at the Jeffers Unit.

Should you choose for your child to attend both Academic Enrichment and Early Bird, you may select from the following options:

- 4 wks of Academic Enrichment with 4 wks of Early Bird only  
Session 1 (June 8 - July 2)  
or Session 2 (July 12 - August 6)
- 4 wks of Academic Enrichment with 10 wks of Early Bird  
Session 1 (June 8 - July 2) with 10 weeks of Early Bird  
or Session 2 (July 12 - Aug. 6) with 10 weeks of Early Bird
- 8 wks of Academic Enrichment with 10 weeks of Early Bird  
Sessions 1 and 2 with 10 weeks of Early Bird

## Mitch's Kids Options

If your child is currently in, or qualifies for, our Mitch's Kids program, you may attend the Academic Enrichment program at a substantial cost reduction\*. However, your child must attend Academic Enrichment for both sessions plus the week between those sessions, for a total of 9 weeks (June 8<sup>th</sup> - August 6<sup>th</sup>). You may choose for your child to attend Academic Enrichment only, or your child may attend the Early Bird program along with Academic Enrichment.

To qualify for this option, your child must be entering the 2nd grade through the 8th grade AND must qualify for free/reduced lunch, TANF, Medicaid or live in public housing. Members must have a completed Mitch's Kids form. This information must be verified before the Club member is accepted into the Mitch's Kids program.

\*(There will be a limited amount of scholarships available for this option. Parents must meet with Unit Director Larry Stone or Stacey Steele to be considered.)
