The Boys & Girls Clubs of Wayne County Summer Early Bird Program is provided as a service to the parents of our members. The program is designed as an alternative to conventional daycare. Parents can feel confident that their child is in a safe environment where they will receive

- Weekly swimming at the Cordell Pool (*weather permitting*)

Cost: \$300 advanced payment for
all 10 weeks of Early Bird

or

\$35.00 per week, paid weekly
(each additional sibling \$30.00 per week)

See Sharman at the Jeffers front desk for other summer program options and costs.

A parent, guardian, or parental approved designee must enter the building and sign the member in and out each day.

Early Bird participants may arrive anytime after 6:30 AM.

Participants arriving before serving times will receive breakfast, lunch, and a snack. Breakfast is served daily from 8:00 - 8:30 AM. Lunch is served Monday - Thursday from 11:30 AM - 12:00 noon (11:00 - 11:30 AM on Fridays). Snack is served at 3:30 PM Monday - Friday.

Members are not to bring toys, balls, radios, CD players, MP3 players, video games or any other type of electronic devices. **Cell phones are to be used for emergencies only in the presence of the staff person in charge!** Members using cell phones for entertainment or casual use may have them taken away. The phone will be returned to the parent when the child is picked up.

Members may bring money for vending machines.

Please send swimming suit and towel with your child on Fridays. On Fridays, all Early Bird participants will leave the Jeffers Unit at 11:30 AM to go swimming at the Cordell Pool unless the pool is closed. We will return to the Jeffers Unit by 4:00 PM. If the pool is closed, all participants will remain at the Jeffers Unit.

Parents are asked NOT to pick up their children at the pool. If you do not want your child to go swimming or your child cannot stay until at least 4:00, please pick them up at the Jeffers Unit by 11:30 AM.

All members must be picked up at the Jeffers Unit by 6:00 PM.

A \$2.00 late fee will be charged for every 15 minutes after 6:00 PM the child is at the Club. This fee must be paid before the member will be permitted to return to the program.

All Early Bird participants must be a member of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Wayne County. Memberships are \$15.00 per year and are good for one year from the date of purchase.

IMPORTANT!

Members MUST bring their Boys & Girls Club Membership Card with them everyday. This is very important so participants can scan in and out. If members show up without their cards, we will have to charge the parent a \$3 fee to have a replacement card produced.

Drop-In Program

The Drop-In program is available for any Club member to attend the Club and participate in traditional Club activities including the gamesroom, gym, computer lab, arts and crafts, and special events. There is no cost to attend during the Drop-In times, only a current Club membership.

This summer the **Jeffers Unit** will have Drop-In times from 12:00 noon until 4:00 PM, Monday through Thursday.

The Jeffers Unit will NOT be open for Drop-Ins on Fridays.

The **Fairview Unit** will have Drop-In time from 12:00 noon until 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday from June 8th until July 30th. The Fairview Unit will be CLOSED for the remainder of the summer after July 30th.

There will NOT be a Drop-In program offered at the **Central Unit** during the summer.

Members arriving at the Club between 12:00 noon and 12:30 PM can receive a nutritious lunch at no cost. Members can also receive a mid-day snack at 3:30 PM.

Drop-Ins are NOT eligible to attend Friday swims at the Cordell Pool. Swimming is for Early Bird participants only.

All Drop-In participants must be picked up by 4:00 PM.

A \$2.00 late fee will be charged for every 15 minutes after 4:00 PM the child is at the Club. This fee must be paid before the member will be permitted to return to the Club.

Special Activities

There will be several field trips this summer for Early Bird and Drop-Ins. Some of the scheduled field trips include: Cincinnati Reds game, swimming at the New Paris rock quarry, hiking at Cope Environmental Center, Camp Guy, and fishing. Most field trips will have limited space available.

We will be having a Boys & Girls Club Car Show on July 29th at 6:00 PM. The Club members will be voting for their favorite cars. Bring your family and enjoy the Car Show, cookout and DJ. If you have a car you would like to see in the show, it is FREE to enter.

The Club will be having two Sprinkler Parties during the summer. One will be July 8th at 1:00 and the other will be August 12th at 1:00. Every member will attend the party. Please send dry clothes and a towel. The Richmond Fire Department will be providing the water for the Sprinkler Parties.
